

An update from the Benefice team

During the vacancy the usual service pattern has continued. The churchwardens, supported by the Rural Dean (Canon Richard Stainer), are finding stand-in priests to lead communion and other services as required.

Sometimes there may be a need for a change to the normal service arrangements so please keep an eye on the weekly information bulletins and church noticeboards for the latest information.

Our vacancy went live on the church's recruitment website in late August and will be advertised for three weeks in the Church Times beginning on 8th September. Interested candidates will be encouraged to look at our 'Benefice profile', which explains the current situation of the church in our area, what we want our new minister to achieve, and what we can offer to help them achieve it. The closing date for applications is 27th September.

Two representatives have been appointed from each parish to take forward the shortlisting and interviewing of the candidates. These are Cold Higham—Pauline Pearson and Ken Watts, Gayton—John Rogers and Lisa Gunn, Pattishall—Alison Brierley and Michelle Lloyd and Tiffield—Mike Dean and Philip Titheridge.

Shortlisting and seeking references will happen in October, with interviews being held before the middle of November. The details of all candidates will be kept confidential to the parish representatives.

Numerous benefices are looking for new ministers so it is hard to predict how long we might need to wait before we get a new minister. We will keep PCC members and people in the Benefice informed of progress as recruitment moves forward.

eptember always feels like a new beginning of sorts, I think maybe because it is so reminiscent of our childhoods as every autumn we start a new class, with a new, probably oversized, and shiny uniform on.

Thinking of this moment of change led me to consider Manna House, an organisation that I have been involved in for many years, and one which itself has just started on a new beginning with the retirement of their longstanding and inspirational Co-Founder and Director John Nightingale. This incredibly worthwhile charity provides counselling training for all across the Diocese as well as counselling sessions in Northamptonshire.

The Manna House Trust (www.themannahouseonline.com) seeks to understand, sustain, enrich and transform lives by nurturing and promoting wellbeing, wholeness and recovery. They aim to do this through excellent counselling and therapeutic practice, training and research, expressing Christian service of hope, meaning and purpose.

The increasing need for counselling services to help those suffering from bereavement, depression, abuse, anxiety and stress or troubled relationships means that the demand for these services has never been greater, at a time when



many are facing a cost of living crisis and donations to charities are falling.

As Christians, we are called to look after all those suffering in our society; 'Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me' (Matthew 25:40). I commend Manna House to you as my new Bishop's Charity and urge you to consider it in your charitable giving planning for next year, or maybe see if there is someone in your community who may be able to undertake their training to offer support in your local area.
